Description

The Western College of Veterinary Medicine (WCVM) is accepting applications for a three-year clinical residency in anesthesia and analgesia. This is a standard ACVAA approved three-year clinical residency combined with a Master of Science program based on coursework and a research project. Candidates must have a DVM or equivalent degree, and must have completed a one-year internship or have had general practice experience acceptable to the faculty in anesthesiology.

About the WCVM and the VMC

The WCVM Veterinary Medical Centre has recently been renovated with new equipment. We have a 24/7 ICU staffed with registered veterinary technologists. We also provide anesthesia services to the exotic pets and large animal sections and are involved with the local zoo immobilization work.

The college offers specialty services in medical imaging, oncology, radiation oncology, small and large animal surgery, small and large animal internal medicine, ophthalmology, critical care, nutrition, sports medicine and rehabilitation, and exotics.
